Have you survived a traumatic event?

Our study is recruiting participants who have experienced a traumatic event, regardless if the event was related to military service. We enroll participants with and without posttraumatic stress symptoms.

If you are a veteran of the U.S. military between the ages of 18-50 and have experienced a traumatic event, you may be eligible to participate!



This study aims to better understand learning and memory in men and women who have experienced a traumatic event, and certain peptides and hormones that might be involved.

This better understanding will bring us closer to our primary goal of understanding posttraumatic stress and how to treat it.

Participating in the study involves 4 in-person visits at the San Francisco VA Medical Center. Participants will be compensated up to \$225 for time and effort completing study procedures.
